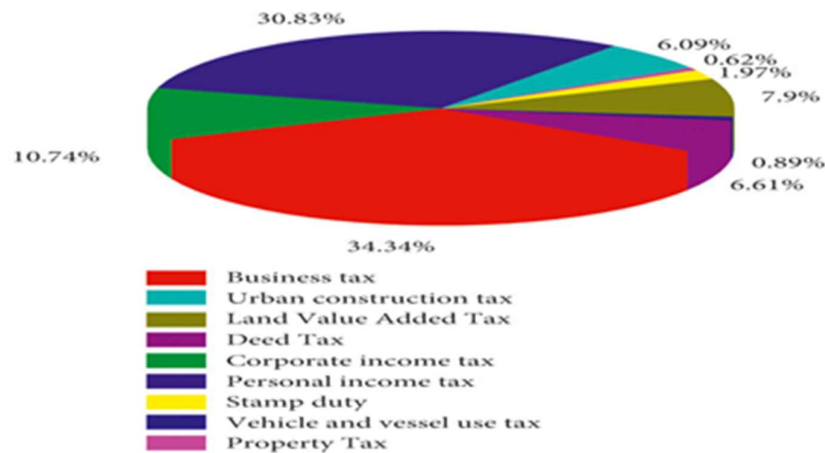


Figure 1. Map of different taxes as a proportion of the total value of all taxes.
